Translating religious books and pamphlets for publication and distribution in the Holy Land.

Maintain the Nasr Priestly Pilgrimage Home, the Grotto of the Twelve Apostles, the Chapel of the Cross of Many Nations, the Shrine to the Mother of God Sayidnaya, and the Sts. Constantine and Helen Guest House.

Dear Friends,

The NOF received the IRS federal income tax status "501 (c)(3)" on July 15, 2011. All contributions are tax deductible.

From March 5th to April 6th, Sharon and I made our pilgrimage to the Holy Land to complete the project of the Nasr Priestly Home and to visit the Greek Orthodox School of Taybeh. During this visit, we distributed \$12,200 for students, families, and a seminarian. Also \$8,000 was used for the completion of the Grotto of the Twelve Apostles, the Chapel of the Cross of Many Nations, the Shrine to the Mother of God Sayidnaya, and the Sts. Constantine and Helen Guest House.

DURING THE LAST YEAR

1. We received the blessing, and endorsement, of His Beatitude Patriarch Theophilos of Jerusalem for the publication of the books *The Bible in the Liturgy* and *Journey through the Divine Liturgy* in arabic.
2. His Beatitude and Ms. Abeer Khouria, principal of the Orthodox School, bestowed upon me a plaque for the years of ministry to the school in Taybeh, along with 4 others including the U.S. Aid representative.
3. Sponsored 12 students who attend the Orthodox school in Taybeh and Jerusalem.
4. Sponsored 9 students who attend vocational school in Ramallah and Jerusalem.
5. Contributed a financial gift to the Taybeh Municipality Youth Council for scholarships.
6. Seminarian Raja Khouri will be residing in the Sts. Constantine and Helen Guest House. He will be working with Fr. Daoud Khouri with the youth. All expenses are paid.

7. Completed the Grotto of the Twelve Apostles, the interior part of the Chapel of the Cross of Many Nations, the Shrine to the Mother of God Sayidnaya, and furnished the Sts. Constantine and Helen Guest House.
8. Since last summer the foundation supported Sub-deacon Joseph Hazar who is studying at the Balamand in Lebanon. He will be returning in May of 2012.
9. Seminarian Raja Khouri will be returning to the Holy Cross Greek School of Theology in Boston, MA in August of 2012 to continue his studies.
10. Monetary gifts, books, and timelines were given to seminarians and missions.
