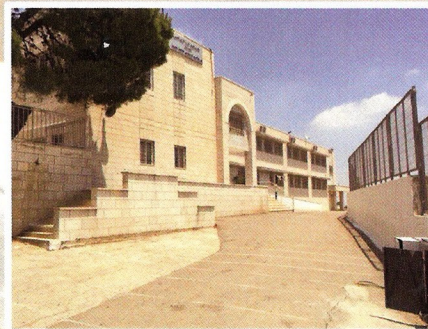

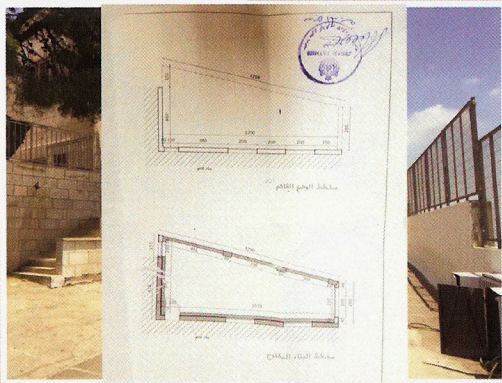

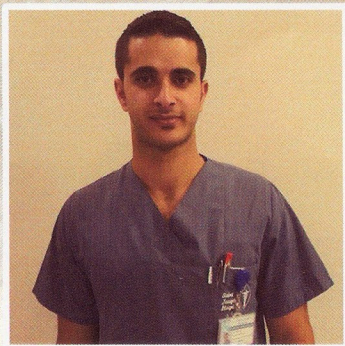
THIS LAST YEAR
